1. Enrollment

2. Qualifications and Requirements

- (A) Nationality: The applicant must be a citizen of a nation recognized under the provisions of the Japanese government scholarship program.
- (B) Age: The applicant who was born between April 2, 1981 and September 30, 1994.
- (C) Academic Background:

1)The applicant must complete a 16-year curriculum of school education by the end of September 2016.

2)The applicant must have 2.30 or more out of 3.0 in MEXT GPA score in the last 2 years (GPA: Grade Point Average).

3)Each applicant has or will have an undergraduate degree of a Japanese university or have the same or a higher level of academic ability by the end of September 2016.

- (D) A person who is both physically and mentally healthy and can pursue studies at KIC for 2 years.
- (E) A person who is proficient in the English language.
- (F) A person who is currently living outside of Japan and can arrive in Japan within the date set by KIC (between mid-September and late-September 2016). In case of failure to arrive, no payment will be made to cover the journey to Japan.
- (G) Visa Requirement: The applicant must acquire a College Student visa before entering Japan and enter Japan with the College Student residence status. Those who change their visa status to other than College Student after arrival in Japan will lose their qualification to be Japanese Government Scholarship recipients from the date of status change.
- Notes:(1) Students cannot be an active member or civilian employee of any military force at the time of enrollment.
 - (2)Students receiving financial support from their government or other organizations are not eligible for this scholarship.

3. Duration of Scholarship

Two years beginning from October 2016 to September 2018

4. Scholarship and Benefits

(A) Allowance: 144,000yen (for reference)

(The amount is subject to change depending on the annual budget of each year)

(B) Travel Expenses:

(i) Japan inbound travel expenses: An economy class airline ticket from the

international airport closest to the student's home to Kansai International Airport will be provided.

(ii) Return travel expenses: An economy class ticket from Kansai International Airport to the international airport closest to the departing student's home will be provided to only those who leave Japan in September 2018, the last month of scholarship period.

% Students are responsible for covering their own travel insurance, airport fee and tax for flights both to and from Japan, and also other travel expenses in Japan.

% Students must use the international airport located in their home country.

(C) Tuition Fees: Fees for entrance examination, admission, and tuition will be waived.

5. Evaluation of Applicants

- (A) Kobe Institute of Computing will review all applicants and select the students to be recommended to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).
- (B) The final results of the Education Ministry's selection process will be notified to the applicants around mid-July 2016. Successful applicants will enroll as regular graduate students of Kobe Institute of Computing.

Successful applicants must fill out and submit "Pledge to the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology" to the Japanese government.

8. Submission of documents for Initial Screening

The applicant should submit the above-mentioned documents <u>by email attachment</u> to the office of Kobe Institute of Computing (global@kic.ac.jp) during the period that is stated in 8-(A).

9. Selection

Initial selection will be conducted by screening the application documents.

Those who have passed the initial selection will have an interview via Skype Video Phone or internet telephone in February 2016.

10. Submission of Original documents for Successful Applicants

Successful applicants who have passed an interview should submit <u>original</u> application documents to the office of Kobe Institute of Computing (see 13. for the postal address).

Note: -Applications that arrive after the deadline, that lack any of the necessary documents stated above, or that are not properly filled out as instructed WILL BE DISREGARDED.

-Use size A4 paper for all documents.

-PRINT DOUBLE-SIDED. Single-side print is not acceptable.

-Do not staple your picture to the application form. Use glue.

-Do not staple your documents. Use paper clips if needed.

11. Note

(A) Scholarship will be terminated if :

- (i) Any of the information in the submitted documents is false.
- (ii) The pledge to the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology is violated.
- (B) Any student takes a temporary leave or is absent from school for an extended period, the payment of the scholarship will be suspended.
- (C) Successful applicants are expected to study and understand the customs, habits, climate in Japan, and the conditions of the University before arrival. Although basic research studies will be mostly in English, students will need to learn basic Japanese in their daily lives.
- (D) Successful applicants are expected to come equipped with a notebook PC.

12. Privacy Protection

All personal information obtained by KIC through processing the application and examination of the applicants shall be handled in accordance with the Japanese 'Law on Protection of Private Information by Government Agencies etc.' as well as 'Procedures for Protecting Private Information' established by KIC. The information may be used only for the evaluation of the application and educational purpose.
