KIC offers the Fully Online Course Program for students. With the Program, students can take online, all the subjects required for completion of KIC Regular Course Program, in order to obtain a master's degree (Master of Information Systems (Professional)). No need to commute to school.

**Online" refers to the situation in which a terminal, such as a personal computer, is connected to the Internet.

KIC's online classes are interactive remote classes. Lectures and seminars are conducted by using a web conferencing application, Zoom Cloud Meetings, as standard.

- Normally, the term of the Regular course program is two years, but it can be completed in three or four years in combination with the Long-Term Course Program.
- Students who live within commuting distance can also take the Full Online Course Program.
- Students can enroll in the Program while working.
- Interactive lectures and research guides are provided online, unlike the conventional non-interactive "correspondence course program".

Regular Course Program (A HyFlex learning system*) and Fully Online Course Program


Please see below for how the Regular Course Program (A HyFlex learning system) differs from the Fully Online Course Program.

* Hyflex" stands for "Hybrid and Flexible. Under the Regular Course Program, students can take a combination of three-mode learning: face-to-face (interactive), online (interactive), and video (reverse instruction).

Regular Course Program (A HyFlex learning system)

- Lectures and seminars (research guidance) are given in classrooms, laboratories, or homes, and are delivered online.
- Students can take classes in either of the following ways:
- Face-to-face (individually or in a group) in a classroom or other places
- (2) Online at home or other places, simultaneously and interactively


XIn addition to the above, video learning (reverse instruction) may be provided.



Fully Online Course Program

- Lectures and seminars (research guidance) are given in classrooms, laboratories, or at homes, and are delivered online.
- Students who have taken the Full Online Course Program can take online classes (simultaneously and interactively) at home or other places

⁻ Lectures are held according to the teaching schedule based on Japan Standard Time(From 9:30 to 22:00). The same applies to research guidance such as Specific Thema Study (seminars). Please be careful if you are going to take classes from overseas where there is a time difference from Japan.

- In some cases, research guidance may be held other than the specified class periods of KIC. Please consult your research supervisor about that.
- Please be reminded that students enrolled in the Fully Online Course Program are not allowed to use KIC school facilities regularly, except for KIC library. If students wish to attend classes in KIC facilities or use

KIC laboratories, they will be considered Regular Course Program students, and therefore be required to return the tuition fee that they were exempted from paying as a Fully Online Course student.

- In principle, students enrolled in Regular Course Program are not allowed to switch to Fully Online Course Program after filing.
- Students may borrow books from the KIC library. But, KIC does not accept postal borrowing/returning.

How to Enroll in Fully Online Course Program

Please fill out the "Application Form for Fully Online Course Program" attached to the Application Guidelines and submit the Form along with your other application documents.

- *Please be reminded that KIC does NOT accept
 - applying for the Full Online Course Program after filing the Entrance Application Form, and
 - changing to the Full Online Course Program after enrollment.

School Expenses

For those students who have taken the Fully Online Course Program, in total for two years, 400,000 JPY will be reduced from the tuition fee.

※1Tuition Exemption is a scholarship of 200,000 yen per year granted to privately-funded applicants of Japanese nationality who have completed the prescribed procedures. For foreign students, other 留学生支援奨学金 may be available.

※2 Students who wish to apply for the Benefit(専門実践教育訓練給付金) must satisfy the required conditions. For details, please ask the nearest "Hello Work" (Public employment security office).

FAO

- Q. Can I complete all of the courses only online?
- A. Yes, you can. Some elective courses require face-to-face attendance, but it is possible to fulfill the requirements for graduation without selecting or registering for these courses.
- Q. Is there any difference between a degree earned through the Fully Online Course Program and a degree earned through the Regular Course Program?
- A. No difference. In both Programs, the same Master of Science in Information Systems will be earned.
- Q. Is this a "Correspondence Course Program"?
- A. No, it isn't. KIC's Fully Online Course Program allows students to take online, lectures and seminars (research guidance) of the Regular Course Program. It is not a "Correspondence Course Program," but a program referred to in the Standards for the Establishment of

Universities, Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools, and Standards for the Establishment of Professional Graduate Schools as consisting of "classes to be conducted in places other than classrooms/laboratories, using a variety of media at a high level which is. Instead of one-way education, lectures, and research guidance are provided in an interactive manner.

- Q. Can I take lectures whenever I want?
- A. Classes are conducted in accordance with the Japan-time schedule (From 9:30 to 22:00). For details, please refer to Page 3 of the Guidelines. If you are taking an interactive online class, you must attend the class at a designated time.
- Q. What are the requirements to complete the program (for the purpose of obtaining a degree)?
- A. Completion requirements are the same as for the Regular Course Program.
- Q. Can I enroll from abroad?
- A. You can enroll from abroad. All entrance exams are also conducted online.

Courses and seminars (Specific Theme Study) are held according to the Japan-time schedule. If you are planning to enroll from a country with a time difference, please confirm in advance (before enrolling) whether you can take classes at a designated Japan time.

- Q. Can I switch from the Regular Course Program to the Fully Online Course Program and vice versa?
- A. Application for the Fully Online Course Program must be made at the time of filing the entrance application. In principle, students are not allowed to change from the Regular Course Program to the Fully Online Course Program after enrollment.

In some cases, a student may be permitted to change the Program with the approval of the President of KIC. However, the student will be required to return the tuition fee exempted from paying for the Fully Online Course Program.
